RE: Eel Weir and Dundee License Amendment Applications

P-2984-ME, P-2942-ME, Dichotomy Power Maine LLC and Presumpscot Hydro LLC

Dear Secretary Bose,

Dichotomy Power Maine LLC and Presumpscot Hydro LLC (the Licensees), co-licensees for the Eel Weir and Dundee projects, are pleased to submit a Non-Capacity License Amendment Application to amend the licenses for both projects. The majority of the application is being filed publicly, but the Preliminary Revised Exhibit F's for Eel Weir will be uploaded as CUI/CEII. This application will be publicly available on [dichotomypower.com/license-applications/](http://dichotomypower.com/license-applications/).

Due to the deadlines imposed by the DOE's Grid Development Office's Section 243 incentive program, the Agencies have not been afforded the full period traditionally provided to resource agencies for comment prior to submission to FERC. However, as additional comments are received from stakeholders, they will immediately be filed with FERC, with licensees' responses, if appropriate.

The licensees are aware of the consultation requirements of 18 CFR 4.38(a)(7), which requires agency review of draft non-capacity license amendment applications 60 days prior to filing with FERC. The licensees respectfully request that FERC waive the requirements of 18 CFR 4.38(a)(7) related to circulation of a draft application for 60-day agency review prior to filing with FERC. They believe this is reasonable because of the minor environmental effects of this proposed action, with no changes in project operations related to flows or lake levels, and because the licensees have informed all agencies of the proposal, with only minor comments received to date. The licensees consulted with the agencies prior to filing, and are, concurrently with the submission of this application to FERC, providing a copy of the final license amendment application to the agencies and soliciting their feedback and comments. As noted, the licensees will supplement this application with any additional comments received and will continue to consult with interested stakeholders as we proceed with this license amendment.
